

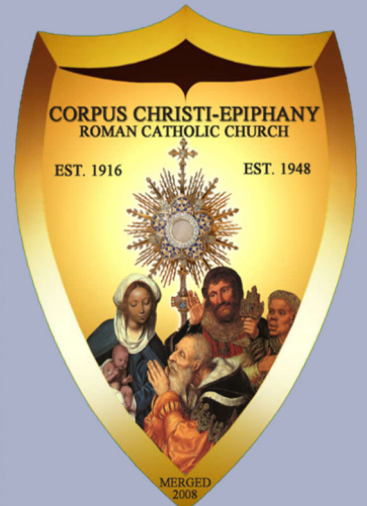

Psalm: Let all the earth cry out to God with joy. (Ps 66) Or Alleluia.

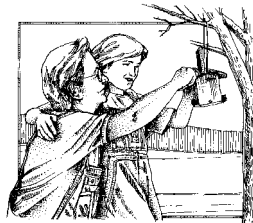
Second Reading: For Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God. (1 Pt 3:18)
