

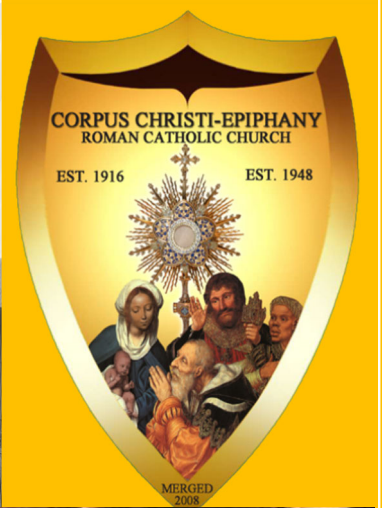

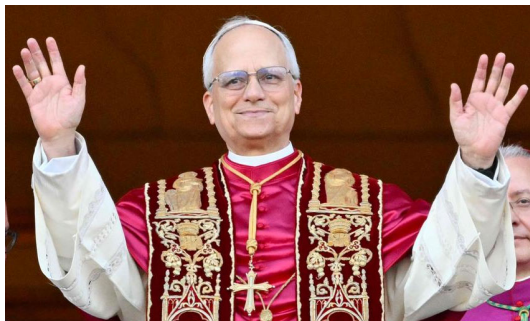


Father in heaven,
