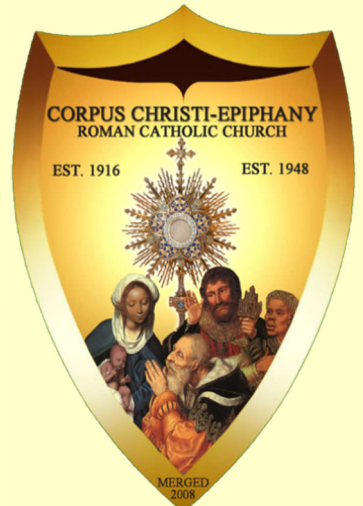

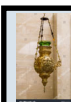

BAPTISM

Baptism is the first Sacrament of Initiation by which we are freed from original sin. Children may be baptized from infancy to age six and after age 6 children must receive the Sacrament of Baptism through RCIA. Baptisms are usually held after the 10 a.m. Mass on the 3rd Sunday of the month. Parents and godparents are required to attend a baptism preparation seminar prior to the baptism of their child.
